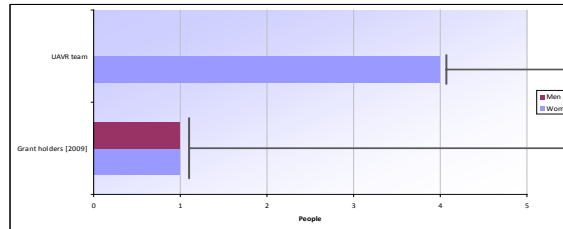


# Gender related issues in Mação, Portugal

The balanced participation of women and men in political and public decision-making is at the heart of the functioning of pluralist democracy. (Council Of Europe, 2007)

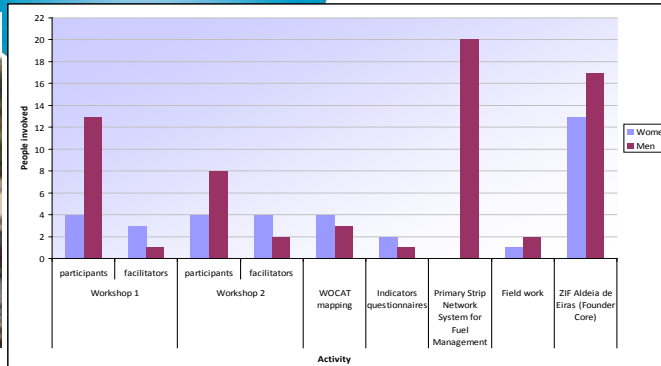
